It is a film made about a real life space mission in 1970 that went horribly, almost fatally wrong but was saved by the ingenuity of the NASA team on the ground and the resourcefulness of the astronauts in space. The above clip is taken from the film when an explosion has ruptured the oxygen tank in the spacecraft. It means that the astronauts will soon run out of oxygen to breathe unless a carbon dioxide filter is made using only the materials that the astronauts have in their spacecraft...it is an unbelievably tense moment in the film! If you haven't watched it before it is definitely worth watching (it is a PG so should be ok for you, but check with mum/dad first!)
