Fun science challenge

Do you have a dandelion in your garden that is ready to disperse its seeds? If so you could create a fun science challenge.

1. First you will need the seeds and a measuring tape.
2. Then carefully remove a single seed and hold it as high you can.
3. Let it go and measure the distance it travels (remember to pick it up again as you mum and dad may not want more dandelions growing in your garden).
4. Complete the challenge about 10 times and see if the book from Learning by Questions was right 'that a dandelion seed travels about 10 metres'
5. Record your findings and message the results to Mr Heyes.
