Monday 8th June	<p><u>Story Time</u></p> <p>To begin this week's mini topic, see if you can find any stories about colour. How about Brown Bear, Brown Bear, What do You See? Or maybe The Day the Crayons Quit, or The Mixed up Chameleon? Share them with your family and have a conversation about colour.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● <i>How many books can you think of with a colour in the title?</i> ● <i>What is your favourite colour? Why?</i> ● <i>What does the colour red/ green/ blue etc make you think of?</i> ● <i>How does the colour blue/ yellow etc make you feel?</i> <div style="display: flex; justify-content: space-around; align-items: center;">   </div>	<p><u>Rainbows</u></p> <p>Can you find something from around your home for each of the seven colours of the rainbow?</p> <p>How about outside? Look carefully at the different coloured leaves, petals, stones etc that you see in your garden or when you go for a walk.</p> <p>Maybe you could find lots of items for each colour and create your own rainbow!</p>

Maths

Today, you can help your parents put a wash on! Sort the washing into colour groups and count how many items there are of each colour.

Add a few drops of food colouring to some milk and use it to paint on a slice of bread! You might want to paint a picture or create a pattern.

PSED - Calm Jars



Colour Mixing

Religious Education

At Nursery, we follow the Come and See Religious Education programme, which is taught by all Catholic schools in the Archdiocese of Liverpool. The new topic for EYFS is Reconciliation so we will share an activity from this scheme each week to support your RE at home - the activities aim to keep RE practical and fun.

Explore: Jesus had friends; We can be friends of Jesus

Activity: Draw a picture of your best friend and talk about why they are your best friend, using *friendship words* e.g. loving, kind, caring, sharing etc. An adult can act as scribe and write these words around your picture. Talk about what you like about your special friend and what you like to do together.
